SELF-DECLARATION OF NEED

Allowing clients to access our food programs through **self-declaration of need** is an important first step in providing equitable service. Hunger is a multi-faceted issue, and we're better able to meet each client's unique needs when we don't have stringent eligibility requirements. From the grandparents who have suddenly found themselves caretakers of grandchildren to the working mom who has been furloughed due to the pandemic—oftentimes our clients face unforeseen situations that don't allow them to wait to qualify for federal or state food programs because they're in need of help right now. When you are feeling overwhelmed and anxious, even the smallest barrier can seem enormous. At the end of the day, feeding people is KLF's primary concern and where we spend our energy.

Since March 2020, we've provided

HUNGER AND HOMELESSNESS

Homelessness is a complex and multi-layered issue. A roof over one's head is something we tend to take for granted but, when it is not attainable, it complicates many aspects of life. Though Kalamazoo Loaves & Fishes has always supported

individuals who are homeless or in transitional housing, this past year provided the opportunity to dig a lot deeper and assist those individuals and families in a more customized way.

For more than three years, we have regularly connected with local homeless encampments to identify needs and make food deliveries. We are currently working closely with Integrated Services of Kalamazoo, Open Doors, Healthy Babies Healthy Start, and Urban Alliance to support residents to meet multiple needs at the same time. For example, there was a recent effort to move community members to the Knights Inn to get them temporarily off the street during cold winter weather. This collaborative, inter-agency assistance allows for residents to access multiple services simultaneously, including regular access to food.

For KLF, food is a basic human right. One major complication of properly serving individuals and families in transition is the lack of cooking facilities or cold storage for perishable food. Thanks to weekly visits by key KLF staff, we have gotten a great deal of feedback regarding the food that is most desired and most useful. Non-perishable food that is ready-to-eat with high levels of protein and calories, such as canned ravioli or hearty stews, are items that typically work well. Smaller, more frequent food packs make more sense for some

residents due to storage issues. What we have learned the most from our experiences is that each situation is unique. It is important to listen, learn and serve as a connector to other non-food related community resources.

WELCOMED AND NEEDED FOOD DONATIONS

CONNECTING WITH FAMILIES

With Kalamazoo Public Schools operating on a virtual model, our 12 school-based pantries have been closed since last March. Since that time, we've worked closely with Communities in Schools of Kalamazoo (CIS) to figure out alternative ways of supporting families with food insecurity. Several CIS Coordinators have frequently picked up food orders and delivered them to families. CIS and personnel from different Kalamazoo County schools have helped spread the word about KLF programs to their students and families. Yet, we felt we could do more. So we took the show on the road! Since November we've been rotating Mobile Food Distributions at school buildings throughout the county. Distributions have occurred at Kalamazoo Central HS, Loy Norrix HS, Phoenix HS, Comstock HS, Linden Grove MS, Spring Valley Elementary, Prairie Ridge Elementary, and Lincoln Elementary. These extra distributions have proven to be excellent outreach events by providing both food and information to families who hadn't visited KLF prior. We plan to continue these school distributions through the summer and will re-evaluate for the 2021-2022 school year. Once scheduled, school distributions are posted on our Facebook page and kzoolf.org.

ONE YEAR ON THE BOOKS!

On March 17, 2020, KLF launched a service model to address the needs of the community during a global pandemic. It's hard to believe it has already been one year! Since last March, KLF has:

- o Adjusted to a curbside, pickup model at pantries
- o Served 1,546 new families
- o Launched a home delivery program that has served over 4,000 households
- Provided over 84,956 four-day food orders
- Held 112 Mobile Food Distributions serving over 10,100 households, including two each month at schools throughout the County
- o Worked closely with over 25 partner agencies and pantries to provide emergency food boxes and packs on a regular basis
- o Supported the basic needs of individuals who are homeless and/or in transitional housing by providing over 2,300 food packs and connecting them to additional resources in the community

FEDERAL AND STATE PACKAGES FIGHT HUNGER

In an effort to help those struggling to make ends meet during the pandemic, federal and state economic stimulus packages are providing a plethora of food resources to families. The ebb and flow of these benefits have impacted the demand for KLF services throughout the pandemic. While we've recently seen slow periods, we anticipate an increase in need this summer as some government assistance programs phase out.

The benefit changes include, but are not limited to, the following:

SNAP

- o 15% increase to the maximum SNAP benefits until September 30, 2021
- o Increase of about \$25 per person per month
- o Expands eligibility to college students

P-EBT

o Virtual students eligible for free or reduced meals in schools will receive extra P-EBT funds. These are retroactive to September 2020 and will continue through June 2021. In districts that provide free and reduced for ALL students, like KPS, every student will receive these benefits.

UNEMPLOYMENT

o \$300 per week federal unemployment subsidy that ends September 6, 2021.
