


MEET ANDREW

"Me and my family are homeless, staying with friends and family when we can," shared Andrew when he reached out to make an appointment. His family consists of two adults and three children under the age of 5 years old. "We get a small amount of food stamps, but by the end of the month, we run out." Andrew is hoping to find a permanent place to live soon, but it's difficult to find something they can afford. "We just need help for a couple of weeks while we try to get on our feet," stated Andrew.

MEET DEE

"My family has fallen on hard times," Dee expressed when she contacted KLF. "First time we have been in a situation like this." Dee, a mother of four children, continued to share that she fell three months ago and suffered a serious back injury, placing her on medical leave and cutting the household income in half. "The doctors have tried a new therapy that is supposed to speed healing. Hopefully it works!" While recovering, Dee decided to take a couple of virtual classes to further pursue her education and eventually improve her employment opportunities.







MEET OKPARA

Okpara is working towards a master's degree in computer science at the local university, scheduled to graduate next spring. As part of his program, he is working with faculty and other students on an integrative software platform design. While this program is great experience, it does not allow Okpara time to work more than occasional tutoring of undergraduate students. Okpara knows that, when he graduates, there will be ample job opportunities. But for now, he is struggling to buy groceries. "My religion requires me to eat only halal prepared meat," shares Okpara. "I appreciate that is an option at Loaves & Fishes."



Your Choice: Shopping, Curbside Pickup, or Home Delivery

The Grocery Pantry Program (GPP) is KLF's most utilized program, serving over **750** people each day and nearly **34,000** unduplicated people every year. Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, all KLF pantries were set up like a grocery store, and clients shopped following a point system based on household size. However, the constraints of the pandemic forced KLF to look at service a point system based on household size. Many temporary service changes became permanent in response delivery differently and to be creative. Many temporary service changes became permanent in response to client feedback. Today, when an individual contacts KLF to make an appointment, they have several choices:



- **1. Curbside Pickup.** KLF's Melzer Pantry, located adjacent to our warehouse, provides curbside pickup Monday Friday. Each day, between 140 160 households are scheduled at the Melzer Pantry. A standard order includes milk, bread, butter, cereal, frozen meat, fresh produce, and a selection of non-perishables. Any dietary restrictions or special requests are noted when the appointment is scheduled. This option is quick and efficient, which is welcomed by clients with time constraints or who have young children with them.
- **2. Shopping.** There are nine locations in the KLF pantry network that offer in-person shopping. Like the previous grocery store model, clients receive points based on household size and "spend" those points on food items. While the same food items are available to all locations, shopping allows the client to select specific items they prefer (i.e. canned corn versus canned green beans). This option is favored by individuals who have dietary concerns or who enjoy the social aspects of visiting a pantry.
- **3. Home Delivery.** KLF started home delivery the first week of pandemic shutdowns, and this program quickly became an essential element of our service delivery. Over time, the program has grown to provide nearly 70 home deliveries every day. Anyone in Kalamazoo County is eligible to receive a delivery. This option has provided greater access for individuals without transportation, with health or mobility issues, or those who need to ration their gas throughout the week.

These service options increase equitable access to food assistance and help meet the diverse needs and challenges faced by our community.




