

November SNAP Benefits FAQ

I received information that my SNAP benefits for November will be delayed. Is this true?	Yes, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) received notification from the federal government's Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Nutrition Services (FNS) that because of the federal government shutdown, there may be a delay with November SNAP benefits.		
How many months will benefits be impacted?	Currently, there is only an expected delay for November benefits. MDHHS will continue to monitor the situation.		
When the federal government shutdown ends, will I still receive my November SNAP benefits?	Yes, once FNS notifies MDHHS that they are legally allowed to release November SNAP benefits, they will be loaded on your EBT card.		
Can I still apply for SNAP benefits during the federal government shutdown?	Yes, households should continue submitting applications. MDHHS specialists will continue to process SNAP redeterminations and case changes.		
Am I still able to use the current funds on my EBT cards in November?	Yes, you can use any SNAP funds that are already on your EBT card.		
I've heard that the State of Michigan might be able to use its funds temporarily to cover SNAP benefits?	The USDA has notified states that, despite their willingness, states cannot cover the cost of benefits and be reimbursed.		
What can I do to prepare for the delay in November benefits?	Call 2-1-1 or visit MI211.org/foodassistance for more information. A list of local food resources is also included on the back side of this flyer.
